After your event, donations should be mailed to Spina Bifida Association, 1600 Wilson Blvd, Suite 800, Arlington, VA 22209 along with a note describing your event. All funds raised should be sent to SBA within 30 days of your event date. Please do NOT send cash by mail. Convert cash to a check or money order. Make checks out to Spina Bifida Association.
